

Cookies policy

1. What information do we collect?
1.1. We do not collect any automated information, with the exception of the information contained in cookie files.

2. What do we use your information for?
The information we collect from you may be used to improve our website (we continually strive to improve our website offerings based on the information and feedback we receive from you).

3. How we use cookies

3.1. Cookies are small files that a site or its service provider transfers to your computer's hard drive through your Web browser (if you allow) that enables the sites or service providers systems to recognize your browser and capture and remember certain information. We use cookies to understand and save your preferences for future visits and compile aggregate data about site traffic and site interaction so that we can offer better site experiences and tools in the future.

3.2. We may contract with third-party service providers to assist us in better understanding our site visitors. These service providers are not permitted to use the information collected on our behalf except to help us conduct and improve our business.

3.3. If you accept the use of cookies, we may place the following cookies on your device:

Google Analytics (website usage analytics)

__utmb

Used to establish and continue a user session.

Non persistent session cookie.

Expires 30 minutes from last user interaction.

__utmc

Operates in conjunction with the __utmb cookie to determine whether or not to establish a new session for the user.

Non persistent session cookie.

Expires at the end of a user session.

__utmz

Stores the type of referral used by the visitor to reach our site. Another copy of this cookie is also set by our payment gateway provider when the user submits payment details.

Persistent third party cookie.

Expires six months from set/update.

3.4. If you have not accepted the use of cookies by clicking "I'm fine with that" when requested to accept cookies, we will only use such cookies that are strictly necessary to run the website and ensure the basic functionality of our services.

3.5. Any cookies placed by us on your device will automatically be deleted when they expire. You can also delete cookies yourself by following the instructions provided by your browser provider.

4. Do we disclose any information to outside parties?

4.1. We do not sell, trade, or otherwise transfer to outside parties any personally identifiable information. This does not include trusted third parties who assist us in operating our website, conducting our business, or servicing you. Such trusted parties may have access to personally identifiable information on a need-to-know basis and will be contractually obliged to keep your information confidential. We may also release your information when we believe release is appropriate to comply with the law, enforce our site policies, or protect ours or others rights, property, or safety. However, non-personally identifiable visitor information may be provided to other parties for marketing, advertising, or other uses.
